Various factors such as the hot springs, the royal road and the Monar irrigation channel determined its rise and growth.

"SPA TOWN AND SUMMER HOLIDAY TOWN"

The current heritage and structure of la Garriga are marked by the mass arrival of summer holidaying at the end of the nineteenth century and beginning of the twentieth century. Eclectic, modernist and noucentista buildings guide us along a small tour which will allow us to glimpse inside the bourgeois world of a century ago.



"HERITAGE AND MEMORY"

The imprint the Civil War left in La Garriga constitutes a large part of the town's memory, and is closely linked to the architectural heritage.

We propose, therefore, a walk through the town centre of la Garriga, retracing some of the main sites connected to the memories of the war whilst, at the same time, admiring and enjoying the heritage of our town.
