



This is an enlargement of that part of the original map of the illegal McMahon Line showing the western end of the Line. It can be seen that the western extremity of the Line is at $27^{\circ}44.6' N$, $91^{\circ}39.7' E$, that the Line runs from here eastward, and that the Kechilang River and the Che Dong area are north of the Line. But the Indian side insists that the western extremity of this Line is at $27^{\circ}48' N$, $91^{\circ}40' E$. In this way the Line is pushed north of the Kechilang River. This is arbitrarily shifting the position of the so-called McMahon Line. The Indian troops' intrusion into the Kechilang River and the Che Dong area on this pretext was all the more a deliberate violation of the line of actual control between the two sides and a provocation of armed conflict.
