27-28 February 1993 Krefeld, Germany

On 12 September 1992, Abimael Guzman, known as Chairman Gonzalo, the leader of the Communist Party of Peru (PCP), was arrested by the Peruvian government.

Within 3 days, the International Emergency Committee to Defend the Life of Abimael Guzman (IEC) was formed in London, England.

The campaign has now been underway for 4 months, and already involves thousands of people from over 40 countries. So far, we have sent 17 delegates in 3 delegations to Lima to investigate and protest the secret military tribunal of Dr Guzman and the gross human rights violations of the conditions of incarceration now endured by Dr Guzman and the other political prisoners in Peruncluding threats to reinstate the death penalty for the purpose of executing Dr Guzman and the political prisoners. The IEC is now also undertaking the defence of the lawyers of these

political prisoners, many of whom have recently been arrested, subjected to military tribunal and sentenced to life imprisonment.

The IEC Founding Conference will be a rare gathering of many of these activists and other interested individuals from around the world.

At this Conference, 100s of people will be coming together to learn more about the situation in Peru and the development of this unprecedented campaign.

At this Conference, we will be making the crucial plans to meet the challenge before us: expanding and intensifying the defence of Abimael Guzman and the other political prisoners of Peru by developing our organization to the level which the situation demands.
