A new hospital was built in the city of Samjiyon, Ryanggang Province, Democratic People's Republic of Korea, and opened to the public in October Juche 109 (2020).





Koryo Medicine

Koryo medicine is the traditional medicine of the Korean nation.

This medicine has contributed to preventing and treating various diseases by means of biological resources abundant in the country and acupuncture, moxibustion, massage and other unique therapies. Having developed to suit the living customs of the Korean people and their physical constitution, it has

characteristics distinguishable from the traditional medicine of the East Asian countries in terms of theory and therapy.

Today it is subdivided into branches of internal medicine, pediatrics, obstetrics and gynaecology, acupuncture, epidemiology, otorhinolaryngology, ophthalmology, diagnostics, pharmacology, tonics and so on.







District Doctor System

In the DPRK the district doctor system has been in force since the 1960s. The system, aimed at preventing and treating diseases by doctors in charge of a certain residential area, has further developed as a medical service network was established, which covers not only the capital city, provinces, counties and ri (dong)—the terminal administrative units—but also factories and other enterprises, and the number of medical workers increased.

The doctors go to the households and workplaces under their charge and provide various kinds of medical service, like arranging the hygienic improvement of the working and living environment and conditions and taking measures for preventing and treating diseases.
