The great leader Comrade Kim Il Sung led our Party and people to victory in the war with his outstanding and refined guidance. It marked the beginning of the downfall of US imperialism and rendered an immortal contribution to the development of the world revolution.

The US imperialists started the Korean war, and they are the sworn enemy of our people.

They are attempting to shift the responsibility for starting the war onto us, but they cannot possibly distort the stark truth of history.

Having occupied south Korea in the place of the Japanese imperialists after the Second World War, they frantically set about preparing for a war against the northern half of Korea. They pushed ahead with their preparations from the first days of their occupation of south Korea, and at dawn on June 25, 1953–a Sunday–together with their south Korean puppets, they launched an all-out surprise armed invasion of the northern half of Korea.

This posed a grim danger for our country and people.

When war broke out in Korea, many people around the world were deeply concerned for the Korean people. They doubted whether the young Democratic People's Republic of Korea would be able to defeat US imperialism, which boasted of being the "strongest" in the world.

The Fatherland Liberation War was a grim fight that was decisive to the destiny of our Party and people; it was the period of their harshest trials. The US imperialists made desperate efforts to crush our Republic in its cradle—hurling huge forces and colossal amounts of the latest combat equipment to the Korean front and resorting to every conceivable method and means with a barbarity that was unprecedented in the history of warfare. But whatever they tried, they could not bring our people, who were firmly convinced of the validity of their cause and solidly united around their Party and leader, to their knees.

The heroic Korean people and the Korean People's Army, by giving full play to their mass heroism under the wise guidance of the great leader, repulsed the brigandish armed invasion by the US imperialists and won a brilliant victory in the Fatherland Liberation

War. It was a miracle without any precedent in the world history of warfare that such a young and small country, which had been liberated no more than five years before, won a war against the allied imperialist forces headed by the United States.

Our people's historic victory in the great Fatherland Liberation War was the great fruition of the outstanding guidance of the respected leader.

In achieving victory in the war, the great leader, with his outstanding and refined leadership, rallied the entire Party and all the people into a single political force.

An army and people firmly united around their party and leader are decisive to achieving victory in a revolutionary war. Unity means certain victory and division leads to defeat.

The great leader, considering invincible unity and cohesion of the Party and the people to be the key factor for winning the war, strengthened the Party organizationally and ideologically and, based on this, rallied all the people and the entire army closely around the Party in a single political force. Then he roused them for the fight to defend the sovereignty of the country and nation.

Immediately after the outbreak of the war, he sent a

The leader often remembers him. This story clearly shows how genuine and solid was the iron faith of our people who, having entrusted their destiny entirely to the leader, believed in and followed him alone, as well as the unity and cohesion of the masses of the people who were firmly rallied behind him.

The great leader defeated the numerically and technically superior enemy by dint of his outstanding military strategies and tactics, and unique art of command.

It is only by fighting with scientific strategies and tactics and an adroit art of command that one can defeat invaders by effectively mobilizing the inexhaustible might of the army and people.

Based on the Juche standpoint, the great leader constantly created original strategies and tactics and a novel art of command, and skilfully applied them.

He dealt the aggressors annihilating blows at every stage of the war, while maintaining a firm hold on the initiative by always applying offensive strategies and tactics. This was a wise strategic policy which was based on a correct analysis and assessment of the prevailing situation, the balance of forces between us and the enemy, and the enemy's weaknesses.

Through his outstanding military strategies and tactics and refined art of command, he transformed misfortune into blessing also in the most testing periods. When a highly unfavourable situation was created due to a considerable difference in strength between us and the enemy, he advanced the extraordinary policy of executing a temporary strategic retreat in a short span of time and then rapidly switching over to counterattack. This was a positive, offensive policy that succeeded in promptly reorganizing our forces while preserving and strengthening them, and in delivering a renewed, decisive blow to the enemy.

While organizing and commanding the strategic retreat, he took the bold and wise measure of forming a second front behind enemy lines, which would disperse and weaken the enemy's forces and strike them powerfully from both the front and the rear. The formation of the second front was a truly outstanding military strategy which allowed us to tip the situation in our favour and firmly maintain the initiative in the fight against the incomparably superior enemy forces.

All the military strategies, tactics and art of command advanced by the leader were completely original and bold ones that could not be fathomed through any existing military knowledge and formulas.

On the basis of a full calculation of the requirements of modern warfare and the actual situation in our country, he created and employed many original tactics. These included combined operations by regular army units and guerrillas and by large units and small units, assault, encirclement and annihilation, mountain warfare, night operations, active positional defence based on tunnels, and tank and aircraft hunting team operations. Our historic victory in the great Fatherland Liberation War demonstrates that consolidating the rear and enlisting a country's entire material and economic potential is a major guarantee of success.

Consolidating the rear and enlisting the country's entire material and economic potential is a law-governed requirement of modern warfare and a major factor in victory. Modern warfare can be called a process of consuming colossal quantities of materiel. Victory cannot be guaranteed without supplying huge quantities of materiel required in the war promptly and by one's own efforts. How the country's material forces are mobilized has a major impact on the war's outcome.

The great leader advanced wartime economic policies which embodied the revolutionary principle of self-reliance, and he inspired the entire Party and all the people to enlist all the material and economic potential of the country for the war effort.

Under his wise leadership, our people placed all the sectors of the national economy on a war footing in a very short period, created powerful munitions industry bases, and ensured smooth wartime production and transport.
