You and we, as well as all the peoples of the world, are today engulfed by a great tragedy: our beloved leader, our great teacher, J.V. Stalin, closed his eyes forever. The mind of the greatest and brightest genius of our times, the illustrious architect of socialism and communism, the creator and delineator of the Communist Party of the Soviet Union and the Soviet state, which are the greatest victory of humanity, has ceased to think. The heart of the greatest friend and defender of the common people of the world has stopped

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


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






